

Vulnerability Disclosure Policy

At Absolent, we take the security of our products and services seriously and welcome responsible disclosure of security vulnerabilities. If you discover a potential security vulnerability in any of our products or services, please contact us by email:

When reporting, please provide as much information as possible, including the affected product or service, version details, a description of the issue, and any steps that may help us reproduce and investigate it. We will acknowledge receipt of your report and begin an initial review swiftly. During the investigation, we may contact you if we need additional information or clarification.

If the reported vulnerability is confirmed, we will take appropriate actions to address the issue and, where relevant, provide security updates or other corrective measures. Where a vulnerability is assessed as serious or is being actively exploited, we will comply with all applicable legal and regulatory reporting obligations, including notifying relevant authorities where required.

To help protect our customers and users, we ask that you do not publicly disclose details of the vulnerability until we have had a reasonable opportunity to investigate and implement any necessary corrective actions.

We expect security testing to be conducted in good faith, responsibly, and without causing harm to our products, services, customers, or other users. Under these conditions, Absolent will not pursue legal action against individuals who report vulnerabilities in accordance with this policy.
